Commitment to achieving Net Zero

Sight Sciences Inc. (“Sight Sciences”) is committed to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions across Scope 1, Scope 2, and Scope 3 emissions by 2050 for its UK operations, in alignment with the UK government Procurement Policy Note (PPN) 006 and the NHS Net Zero Supplier Roadmap. Sight Sciences UK, Ltd. (“Sight Sciences UK”) is a wholly owned subsidiary of Sight Sciences, Inc.

This Carbon Reduction Plan outlines our baseline emissions, current emissions footprint, and the measures we are implementing to reduce emissions in line with UK Government expectations.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured. Emissions have been calculated in accordance with the Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard.

Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations.	
While Sight Sciences did report an initial baseline in 2023 for its UK operations, there were significant changes in our full company reporting in 2024 that impacted our reporting scope. These changes included the following: Total number of categories have increased, the category names have been updated and standardized across our company, and the reporting metric has been updated from tCO2e to kgCO2e. Many of these new Scope 3 emissions categories are not required for a Carbon Reduction Plan but are being included as they are a key part of our energy usage. As a result of this significant change in reporting, Sight Sciences is using 2024 Emissions Reporting as the baseline. This re-baselining has helped us better reflect our current emissions and provide more accurate data for our future analyses and initiatives. The same calculation methodology will be applied to future reporting years to ensure consistency and comparability against this baseline. The emissions data only includes UK operations of Sight Sciences.

Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

Sight Sciences Inc. is committed to reducing Scope 1, Scope 2, and the reported subset of Scope 3 emissions per £ of revenue by 30% by 2030, from a 2024 base year for UK operations.

Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

1. Business Travel Reduction (Scope 3, Category 6):
 - a. Reduced business travel utilizing more virtual meetings with less international flights resulting in a reduction of 61% from the previous year.
2. Electricity Consumption Reduction (Scope 2):
 - a. Moved to Renewable Energy resulting in a 99% reduction from the previous year.

To meet the reduction targets, Sight Sciences UK will implement the following strategies:

1. **Business Travel (Scope 3, Category 6):**
 - **Virtual Meetings:** Promote the use of video conferencing to reduce the need for travel.
 - **Travel Policies:** Recommend travel prioritising lower-carbon transportation modes (e.g., trains over flights for domestic travel).
 - **International Travel Policies:** Reduce total international flights and travel replacing with the utilization of virtual meetings technologies.
2. **Employee Commuting (Scope 3, Category 7):**
 - **Flexible Working:** Continue to support remote working options to reduce commuting emissions.
 - **Sustainable Commuting Incentives:** Offer benefits for employees who use public transportation, cycle, or carpool.
3. **Electricity Consumption (Scope 2):**
 - **Renewable Energy Procurement:** Switch to 100% renewable electricity suppliers.
 - **Energy Efficiency:** Invest in energy-efficient appliances and lighting in office spaces.
 - **Energy Awareness Campaigns:** Educate employees on energy-saving practices.
4. **Waste Management (Scope 3, Category 5):**
 - **Reduce, Reuse, Recycle:** Implement a comprehensive waste reduction program.
 - **Supplier Engagement:** Work with suppliers to reduce packaging and promote sustainable materials.
5. **Upstream Activities:**
 - **Supplier Collaboration:** Engage with suppliers to understand and reduce emissions associated with transportation and distribution.
 - **Sustainable Procurement Policy:** Prioritise purchasing from suppliers with strong environmental credentials.
 - **Transportation Optimization:** Evaluate and reduce emissions associated with international shipment of products into the UK through consolidation and logistics efficiency improvements.

Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 006 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

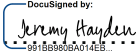
